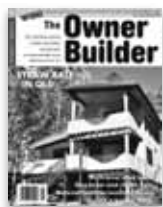

Issues are broken down into files by year, each around 600KB.

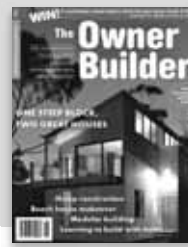
